

Ode Four




I have heard of the mighty deeds of Your Cross: how by them Pa - ra - dise was o - pened,

Ode Five




Wak - ing at dawn, we cry to You, O Lord save us!

Ode Six




The A - byss has co - vered me, the sea mon - ster has be - come my grave;

Ode Seven




You who saved the chil - dren who praised You in the fie - ry fur - nace,
